Community Smiles Dental is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization providing crucial dental care to low-income children, pregnant women, special needs patients, and adults in the Greater Milwaukee area. We continue to place our primary emphasis on serving youth, who disproportionately struggle with access to dental treatment and have nowhere else to turn. Our staff includes some of the most compassionate dental providers in the region, serving as many as 4,000 patients each year. Services include comprehensive oral exams, emergency oral exams, preventive services including oral hygiene instruction, fluoride treatments and sealants, x-rays, restorative services, and extractions.

How do I become a patient?

If you're interested in our services, the first step is knowing whether your family is eligible. You can use this checklist to quickly see if you qualify for our services.

- Have BadgerCare/Forward Health/Medicaid insurance OR are uninsured and have income that falls below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines.
- Reside in Milwaukee County, Ozaukee County, Waukesha County or Washington County

Patient priority is provided to youth age 18 and younger.

For patients without dental insurance, a discounted fee/copay is required.
