Community Smiles Dental is our region's solution for quality and affordable dental care for people with Medicaid insurance or who are uninsured and income qualify. Nearly 4,000 individuals turn to our clinics each year for care. The clinic is staffed by quality dental professionals who provide comprehensive dental care to our patients.

## Program Summary

**Children** **Healthy Smiles for Tot & Teens Dental Program** provides dental services, including preventative and restorative care and education, to children ages 0-18.

**In-School Programs & Partnerships** extend Community Smiles Dental's work to low-income youth in a school or Head Start setting. Dental screenings and sealants are provided on-site, along with oral health and dental care education. All eligible youth served are referred to our clinics for regular and ongoing care.

**Give Kids a Smile Program** is a national effort to eliminate the silent epidemic of dental disease for millions of children. Community Smiles Dental participates annually in February (1-2 days), mobilizing staff and volunteers to screen and serve as many children as possible.

**Pregnant Moms** **Healthy Smiles for Moms and Babies Program** provides dental care and education to low-income pregnant moms, with the objective of ensuring healthy oral habits are carried on to the newborn.

**Special Needs** **Special Smiles Program** serves adults and children with developmental, cognitive and physical disabilities. Both clinics include a special treatment room designed to support the care needs of these patients in an inclusive, quality and compassionate setting. We also sustain a partnership with Children's Hospital of Wisconsin which provides specialized dental care to special needs adults who have aged out of their pediatric dental clinic.

**Adults** **Adult Dental Program** serves low-income and medically fragile adults who lack access to dental care. This program reaches our community's most vulnerable adults. The Adult Dental Program provides basic dental services to address adult's most urgent and emergent needs. Some preventative and restorative care is also offered out of our Menomonee Falls clinic.
